

# Sorting list **bulky waste**

## Small metal items

Pots, pans and cutlery

*Place in clear plastic sack*



## Large metal items

BBQs, garden tools, lawn mowers (petrol tank must be empty), furniture and blinds

## Larger amounts of beer and soft drink cans

*Place in clear plastic sack*



## Large electronic items

PCs, radios/TVs, satellite dishes, vacuum cleaners, aerials and sewing machines

## Small electronic items

Shavers, toasters, cameras, coffee makers, electric cables, small computer accessories and battery-operated toys

*Place in clear plastic sack*



## Large combustibles

Carpets/rugs (rolled up, max. 1.5 metres wide and tied with string), furniture, baskets, garden furniture, sledges and mattresses

## PVC products

Beach balls, rainwear, rubber boots, shower curtains, plastic blinds, garden hoses, synthetic leather products, pools, paddling pools and tents

*Place in clear plastic sack*



## Bicycles

Must be marked as bulky waste or we can't accept them.

Attach a note saying:  
»Bulky waste«

## Paint, varnish and glue

Paint, varnish and glue products

*Place in clear plastic sack*



## White goods

Washing machines, freezers, cookers, dishwashers and dryers

## Batteries and aerosols

Aerosol cans and all types of batteries, except car batteries

*Place in clear plastic sack*



## Large cardboard items

Corrugated cardboard and cardboard boxes (flattened and tied together with tape or string)

**Leave your bulky waste on the pavement outside your home the night before or by 6 am on the day of collection at the latest.**
